**Rules:**

- \* Time in the Schedule is when the practice starts.
- \* Games are timed (one minute between ends).
- \* Players put results on the scoreboard (in the tablet) themselves after each end.
- \* During games if stone measurement is needed players do it themselves. DSC shots are measured by umpires.
- \* 8-end games. Draw doesn't exist, an extra end is played.
- \* Practice time in round robin – 4 minutes. After practice 1 minute for each player to deliver DSC shot (total 6 DSC shots for each team in tournament). Practice time in playoff - 4 minutes.
- \* First team in the Schedule: practice first and plays red stones. Games marked with \* before the time made a coin toss. Winner will have the choice of first or second practice.
- \* After round robin all teams are ranked in the group by 1) win/loss 2) head to head result 3) DSC (5 shots counted, the single least favourable result is automatically eliminated). For play-off games all teams in overall ranking are ranked by 1) place in the group 2) DSC.
- \* Teams ranked from 1 to 4 are playing semi-final. Teams ranked from 5 to 8 are playing for places from 5th to 8th.
- \* Throughout all play-off games when a higher ranked team from any group plays a lower ranked team, the higher ranked team has the choice of stone colour and playing last stone in the first end. In case of equally ranked teams facing off, the team with the better DSC will have the first choice of stone colour or playing last stone in the first end.
