Stones: In round-robin stage, team that is mentioned **first** in the schedule plays with dark stones (**red**). Opponent team plays with light stones (**yellow**).

In the play-offs, team ranked higher can choose either hammer or stone color.

Practice:

Round robin: 5 minutes + DSC. First practice - team mentioned first in the schedule. Games marked with * before the practice make a coin toss. Winner will have the choice of first or second practice.

Play - offs: 5 minutes for each team before game (no DSC), first practices team with last stone advantage in the 1st end.

Ranking :

After round robin teams are ranked in their group by : 1) win/loss 2) head to head result 3) DSC.

Last stone draw (DSC):

- DSC for round robin games after the practice
- In the play-offs, team ranked higher can choose either hammer or stone color

Time in the schedule is when the practice starts.

All games will be played by the WCF rules (unless otherwise specified below or before Tournament).

All games - 8 ends. No ties. If game is tied after 8 ends extra end(s) should be played to determine winner. Thinking time 4 min 30 sec for an end for each team in extra end(s).

Timed Games: 30 minutes thinking time per team; 60 seconds break between ends (coaches can join between ends).

Time-outs exist. 30 seconds for coach to reach closer end of the rink, 60 seconds for further end of the rink.

Tournament will have Umpires, who will solve arguments (if any), make stone measurements. Please put the score on the scoreboard after each end (tap the tablet 2 times to turn it on).

World Curling Rule R3(c). In case you are not able to have all 4 players, 3 player team **is allowed** in this event.
